

Junior Winter Comp Registration Information

All registrations for the 2021 Winter Comp must be completed and paid for online.

The link to the online registration form can be found on the PHNC website (pennanthillsnetball.com.au) under the **Registrations** tab.

Click on the registration you wish to complete. There are two relevant categories

- Juniors: players turning 10-15 years by 31 Dec 2021
- NetSetGo: players turning 6-9 years by 31 Dec 2021

Registration Fees

The 2021 schedule of fees is as follows:

NetSetGo and Juniors:

\$240 if paid by 6/2/2021 ('early-bird discount') \$260 if paid after 6/2/2021

PLEASE NOTE when registering school age children, the Active Kids Rebate (\$100) will be available from 1 January 2021 to apply against your PHNC registration.

HOW TO REGISTER

Existing members

Use your MyNetball login and password to log into the online registration form by selecting 'Return User'. If you don't remember your login details, select 'Forgotten login details' and your information will be emailed to you. If you do not receive this email, it means the email address in the MyNetball system is not correct for you. Please contact the Registrar at phnc.registrar@gmail.com to correct this. **New Members**

If you are new to netball or new to the club and don't know your login details, you will need to enter your details into 'First Time Participant' and then select 'Find Me'. If you are new to netball, there should be no entry for you in which case you will then create a new record. If you have played before, your name should appear in the list of entries. Select 'Email Login' to have your login and password sent to you and then you can log in as a 'Return User'.

Proof of Age: All NetSetGo and Junior players new to playing with the Hills District Netball Association will need to show the club registrar a JP certified <u>copy</u> or original of their birth certificate or passport on the Registration Day held on 6 February 2021. This proof of age document is a requirement by HDNA to complete the registration.

Tips for the Online Registration Form

- The online registration must be completed by the parent or guardian for any player under the age of 18.
- A separate registration form will need to be completed for each family member.
- When you log in as an existing user, many of your details on the registration form will already be there. Please check these for accuracy and make any changes required.
- Payment must be made at the time of registering and can only be made with a credit card (Visa or Mastercard). Please make sure you have this on hand. A service fee of 1.78% of the rego fee plus 31 cents will apply. This service fee is being charged by the provider of the online payment gateway and does not go to PHNC.
- NetSetGo players turning 10 years in 2021 and Junior registrations will be asked to provide a first and second preference for the positions to be graded in on Grading Day. Consider these preferences carefully as, in line with the Grading Policy, the player will be trialled in their first preference but possibly not in their second preference.
- HDNA have requested we ask the Player History questions to assist them with competition grading, hence these are mandatory. If you are unable to answer one of the questions, write in 'unknown' or 'n/a'.

Registration Timeframe

For Juniors and NetSetGo Registration, the online form will be open from 1/1/21 to 20/2/21. This late close-off date is in place to accommodate any approved late registrations. However, **PHNC cannot guarantee a spot in a team for any registrations after 5pm, 6/2/21. All registrations after this date must be approved by the Grading Committee.** An early bird discount will be available until 6/2/21.

Registration Day

Although all registrations are to be completed online, the club will still hold a Registration Day on Saturday 6th February 2021 from 10am-12pm. Please keep an eye on the website for location information. **If you are a new NetSetGo or Junior player**, **you need to submit proof of age documents on the Registration Day.** We will have a laptop set up where we could assist your registration. It is also an opportunity to ask questions and meet the PHNC Executives. If you have successfully registered online prior to the day and don't need to supply a certified proof of age document, there is no need to attend Registration Day.

Uniform

The PHNC uniform consists of a dress, black boy leg briefs and plain white socks that are at least long enough to cover the ankles. The uniform can be purchased directly from the Sydney Netball Shop <u>http://www.sydneynetballshop.com/all-products/pennant-hills-netball-club-dress-2/</u>

Limited uniforms will be available for purchase and to try on for size at Rego Day.

Refund policy

The PHNC By-laws state that "Any player who withdraws from a team after Club registration, will not be entitled to a refund of registration fees unless there are extenuating circumstances. The Executive will then consider whether the whole or any part of the registration fee will be refunded". (By-law 3.f.)

Games

NetSetGo players turning 6-9 years in 2021 play on Friday nights, usually either at 6pm or 7pm. NetSetGo players play modified matches/rules that emphasise fun, participation and learning the basic skills of netball in a non-competitive and safe environment. All other age groups play on Saturdays. Juniors tend to play in the mornings from 8.30am to 12 midday game. All games are played at Pennant Hills Park.

Winter Comp dates

Start date: Friday April 23rd or Saturday April 24th, 2021

Grand Final: Saturday 4th September 2021

Grading Day

Grading Day will be held at the indoor court at Pennant Hills Park indoor court on <u>Sunday, 21st March, 2021</u>. Please keep this day free. Historically, grading has occurred in age order, with NetSetGo players graded early around 8:30am and U/15s graded later in the day around 2pm. The Grading Day schedule will be released after Registration Day, when the club will have a sense of the numbers we have in each age group.

Please ensure you are familiar with the PHNC Grading Policy and Procedures which can be found on the PHNC website under the menu item 'Guidelines and Policies'.
